**Assistant Federal Public Defender**

The Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Oklahoma is accepting applications for the position of Assistant Federal Public Defender for our Trial Unit in Oklahoma City. The Federal Public Defender operates under authority of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 3006A(g)(2)(A). We provide legal services by court appointment to individuals unable to afford counsel. We represent our clients from first appearance through petitioning the United States Supreme Court for certiorari.

**ASSISTANT FEDERAL PUBLIC DEFENDER.** Must be a law school graduate, a member in good standing of any State bar, and either admitted or eligible for admission in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma, the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals, and the Supreme Court. Minimum of three years' criminal trial experience required (preferably federal), as well as strong research and writing skills, in-depth knowledge of criminal law and procedure, and a commitment to the representation of those unable to afford counsel. Salary negotiable, DOE, and is comparable to salaries paid by U.S. Attorney's Office.
